General Information

REGISTRATION-

The registration fee for the program is \$200.00 if paid on or before February 1, 2002 and \$225.00 after that date. LOCATION AND LODGING-

The First Annual KREIA Inspectors Education Conference will be held at the Lexington Ramada Inn North located at 2143 North Broadway, Lexington, Kentucky. A special room rate of \$69.00 per night has been arranged for conference participants and vendors. Please make your reservations as soon as possible to assure room availability. The hotel does not provide an airport shuttle so transportation arrangements from the airport to the conference should also be made in advance. SPEAKERS INFORMATION-

If you are participating in the Conference as a speaker your conference registration, food, refreshments and entertainment are courtesy of KREIA.
